

SFWMD Project Challenges

- 20 plus independent Departments that have both internal and external web presence
- 2000 plus internal users plus external business partners
- Inconsistent Look and Feel
- No Application Integration
- No Common User and Group management
- No Content Management

SFWMD with Portal

- Common Look and Feel
- Content Management
- Common Application deployment framework
- Rapid Application Development (RAD)
 - 8 fairly involved applications
 - Migration of volumes of disparate content to Portal within
- Identity Management

 OID Integration with Existing MS A/D

SFWMD with Portal

- Business Process Improvement
 - -Web Apps
 - Gov Board Agenda and Minutes Tool
 - Saved 200 plus hours/mo
 - All Records now stored in Oracle
 - Plans and Specs Tool
 - Homeland Security Driven
 - Document Management
 - EOC Emergency Briefing Tool

Summary of Portal at SFWMD

<u>BEFORE</u>

- Web development all over the map requiring many servers running different environments to support web-apps
 - .Net, PL/SQL, PHP, JSP, HTML, etc.
- Content Look and Feel completely out of control
- Web Services group central to all content management



- Reduction of Maint. cost via single environment that supports ALL webbased content & apps
- Common Re-usable Templates bring consistent look and feel while reducing time to deploy new content
- Content Management pushed to User Community

Summary of Portal at SFWMD

BEFORE

<u>AFTER</u>

- Little Security controlled mainly by Firewall
- Multiple IDs and passwords – more each time a new application was deployed

- Security and Identity Management through OID
- Create and manage User roles and permission via Groups maintained in OID

Summary of Portal at SFWMD



 Application Development was not able to build on existing security, templates, work flow, user groups, etc. Time to develop web-apps was too long, and the resulting Apps consisted of much redundant code



- Rapid Application Development that builds on common features within Portal, OID, and the Application Server
 - Upgrading and maintenance is only required to a single environment
